

### HISTORY

- ❖ The property was built in the XVIIth century and Jean Jacques Lesgourgues took over it in 1999
- ❖ « *Peyros* » means a stony place in Gascony language, which is representative of this exceptional terroir
- ❖ The 20 hectare vineyard got the Terra Vitis and HVE certification in 2018

### VINEYARD

- ❖ 20 hectares of vines for the southernmost vineyard of Madiran appellation
- ❖ 1,2 ha with southern exposure below the Greenwich Meridian for this cuvée
- ❖ Age of vines : 50 years old
- ❖ Yield : 19hl/ha – 5018 bottles produced

### GRAPE VARIETY

- ❖ 100% Tannat

### VINIFICATION

- ❖ Traditional in a 'plot tank'
- ❖ Fermentation of 25 days
- ❖ Malolactic fermentation in french oak french barrel
- ❖ Ageing 18 months in new french oak barrels (Allary & Gillet)

### AGEING POTENTIAL

Until 25 years old

### TASTING NOTES

- ❖ The nose is very expressive, black fruits, minty and peppery.  
On the palate, the wine reveals high elegance; it is full, fresh and softly powerfull. Tanins are very delicate and perfectly integrated. Already full of charm, this wine will continue to gain in complexity by ageing.

### GOURMET INSTANT

- ❖ To pair with meat such as duck, game (venison, salmi de palombe) or a dark cho
- ❖ To decant one hour before serving.
